Dear Parents/Guardians

As the year draws to a close, I would like to advise how our school fees and charges have been structured for 2021.

The school, in consultation with the *Anglican Schools Commission* (ASC), undertook a comprehensive review of our fees and charges in response to the current Covid-19 climate we are experiencing.

We are pleased to announce that from 2021 there will be some changes to our fee structure to ensure that our school continues to deliver an affordable, inclusive, high quality and caring Christian education to our community, in line with the ASC's Core Purpose for all schools.

Early Childhood tuition fees have been reduced by 25%; whilst other tuition fees have been frozen despite a small Educational Index (CPI) increase of 1% for education costs in Australia (September 2019 quarter to September 2020 quarter). Furthermore, we have introduced a discount to eligible Concession Card Holders.

As of February 2021, all ASC Schools will move to one annual invoice instead of each term. Payment options will be displayed on the annual invoice giving parents a choice of how they wish to make fee payments. We believe this annual invoice will give more fiscal certainty to families and assist them with personal budgeting. To simplify charges; no excursions or subject levies (except Outdoor Education and Advanced Physical Education) will be charged, whilst a modest increase to resource levies has been introduced. More information will be sent out to all families by our Business Manager, Mr Pablo Sandor, over the coming weeks.

The Fee Schedule for 2021 is attached. I encourage you to take the time to read these documents carefully as it sets out the level of fees and charges. Any queries regarding fees and how they apply to your family, should be directed in the first instance to the Bookkeeper, Mrs Wahnita Banwell.

As Chair of the School Council I thank you most sincerely for your continued support of Georgiana Molloy Anglican School. I wish you and your families a Joyful Christmas and a Happy New Year.
