MUSIC TUITION 2018

Students in yr 1 - 12 at Georgiana Molloy Anglican School are currently offered individual or group music tuition in the following specialist instruments:

violin, viola, cello, double bass, flute, clarinet, saxophone, descant recorder, drum-kit/percussion, piano, trumpet, trombone, guitar, bass guitar, musical theory, voice

MUSIC LESSON PROCEDURES:

1. 30 Minute lessons take place within school hours on a rotating basis.
2. Shared lessons are only offered if students of similar ability can be grouped together, and are not available for piano or drum-kit.
3. Parents and students need to be aware that the entire term's fee is payable whether the lessons are attended or not as the student occupies one place in the Instrumental Programme.
4. When adequate notice is given regarding absences as outlined below, and where possible, the tutor will endeavour to make-up missed lessons.
5. If your child is going to miss a lesson due to a test, exam or excursion, the tutor needs to be advised at least 2 days prior to the lesson so that alternate arrangements can be made if possible.
6. If your child is unwell on the day of the lesson, please advise the tutor direct by 7.30am. Your tutor will supply you with contact details at the commencement of lessons.
7. Students missing shared lessons will not have those made-up as the lesson will still be taught to the other student who is present at school.
8. Tutors will re-schedule lessons if they conflict with calendared events, camps and whole school events such as Interhouse Athletics Carnivals.
9. Tutors are not obligated to reschedule lessons when the student is absent due to private family holidays taken during term time or illness.
10. If the teacher is absent and the lesson cannot be rescheduled, a credit will be given.
11. Parents and students should be aware that for adequate progress to be made, there needs to be a commitment to practice regularly at least 4 days each week. Your tutor can give more specific advice in this area.
12. **Only one instrument is recommended** to be studied at a time due to the practice commitment required, and the interruption to class learning.

2018 FEE STRUCTURE:

Term 1, 2 & 3:	\$288.00 for 9 individual lessons \$158.00 for 9 shared lessons
Term 4:	\$192.00 for 6 individual lessons \$106.00 for 6 shared lessons

Tutors will charge you direct for lessons, and all students will be required to sign off for each lesson that they receive. The tutor has the right to stop lessons if accounts are not paid in a timely manner. In case of a dispute that cannot be resolved between the tutor and yourself please contact the Director of Music Mrs Kate Telchadder.

CANCELLING LESSONS:

You are required to commit to lessons for a term at a time and should give at least 1 month's notice of your intention to cease lessons. This should be done in writing and to the end of a term. Please direct this correspondence to the Director of Music. **No credits will be given** if you decide to stop lessons mid way through a term.

STARTING LESSONS:

If you decide part way through a term that you would like your child to commence music lessons you must fill in a Music Tuition Application Form prior to your child commencing lessons. Please also note it is recommended that only one instrument is learnt at a time to reduce impact on in-class learning. Requests for taking 2 instruments need to be approved prior to enrolment. Please contact Mrs Telchadder with any queries regarding this.

INSTRUMENTAL HIRE:

Music instruments are available for hire through Georgiana Molloy Anglican School for a fee of \$55 per term and also through external hire businesses Twinkles String Hire and Musiccorp.
