SCHOLARSHIPS 2019

We welcome scholarship applications from talented students who believe they can make a positive contribution to the GMAS community. The Scholarships are awarded to students who display talent in a variety of areas including, but not restricted to, academia, arts, leadership, physical ability and service to the community. Scholarships are awarded to students who will benefit substantially by attending the school, and who in turn will make a contribution to the holistic life of the school.

Scholarships are open to all students in the greater Busselton region who will be entering Year 7 and 10 in 2019.

In 2019 Georgiana Molloy Anglican School will offer the following scholarships:

2019 Year 7 Scholarships

- Year 7 Two Old Georgian's Scholarships - full tuition fees
- Year 7 Two Principal Scholarships - half tuition fees

2019 Year 10 Scholarships

- Year 10 Two School Council Scholarships - full tuition fees
- Year 10 Two Principal Scholarships - half tuition fees

The Old Georgian's Scholarships are equal value to full tuition fees (100%) for the years of schooling. The Principal's scholarships will be of equal value to half tuition fees (50%) for the full years of schooling. Applicants will not be required to undertake a scholarship selection test, and no payment is required.

Scholarships do not cover the cost of books, stationery, uniforms, discretionary charges such as camps or overseas trips. The continuation of the Scholarship is subject to a successful review of progress and contribution to school life annually.

Tenures vary but generally holders are expected to complete their secondary education at GMAS.

All Scholarship holders are expected to display ongoing sustained commitment to their studies and to take a full and constructive part in the life of the school in the areas of their interests, aptitudes and abilities.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

- I. Scholarship cover sheet;
- II. Student composed covering letter (200 words or less) addressed to the Principal Mr Ted Kosicki briefly explaining why the applicant is applying for a scholarship at Georgiana Molloy Anglican School;
- III. Copy of the applicant's birth certificate;
- IV. Copy of the applicant's Semester 1 & 2, 2017 reports (clearly identified with the applicant's name if scanning);
- V. Copy of the applicant's Year 5 & 7 (only for year 10 candidates) NAPLAN report (clearly identified with the applicant's name if scanning).
- VI. Character reference letter on student's behalf
- VII. Portfolio of evidence (certificates attained, awards gained, commendations, certificates of participation, letters confirming individual/team representative selection)

***No late applications will be considered.**

SCHOLARSHIPS 2019

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Scholarship holders are expected to maintain a high level of commitment to the whole school program. This includes: school attendance, being a positive influence in all classes, completion of work, excellent citizenship, wearing the uniform correctly, attendance at school functions, active contribution to the co-curricular house and voluntary school activities and doing her/his best at all times.
- The family agrees to fully abide by the rules and conditions at GMAS as specified.
- The scholarship supersedes any sibling discounts or special privileges.
- The scholarship will be tenable to the completion of Year 12 provided that the applicant's academic achievement, behaviour and involvement in the co-curricular program are met in line with the expectations of the scholarship.
- The School reserves the right not to award any or all of the scholarships available.
- Should the Principal offer your child a scholarship, acceptance of the scholarship is required within two business days of the offer.
- The number of Scholarships awarded each year is dependent upon the quality of the applicants and the availability of places.

APPLICANT SHORT-LIST SELECTION

- Successful short-listed applicants will need to have provided all of the information requested in full, by the due date.
- Successful short-listed applicants will be notified by mail and telephone.
- Unsuccessful applicants will be notified by email. The selection time frame process does not allow for individual feedback to non-successful applicants.
- Short listed applicants for the Scholarships will be interviewed by a panel including the Principal.
- In consultation with the panel the final decision on awarding any Scholarship rests with the Principal.
